Vancouver enjoys mild winters, and snow is pretty rare in the city. In fact, blossoms start covering trees as early as February. Bikers, hikers and outdoor enthusiasts need not hibernate here, and with mountain slopes just 20 minutes from downtown.

Your full-day tour on the Sea to Sky begins with morning pickup from the Comfort Inn & Suites at 7:45am. Meet your guide and climb aboard the bus, then relax and take in the dramatic British Columbia landscape as you exit the city. Cruise through the Sea-to-Sky corridor, soaking up views of the Tantalus Mountains and the plunging Cheakmus River canyon.

- Our first stop will be: Britannia Mine Museum – 10:00am Climb aboard a mine train and chug into an early haulage tunnel. Inside, our tour guide will describe early mining efforts with actual working drills and a mucking machine. This tour will be approximately 45 minutes and then a walk around and shopping in the museum souvenir shop.



- Next stop 11:45 - 12:00pm, Lunch at the "Brew Pub" in Squamish, (on your own). The Brew Pub is a meeting place in Squamish for both locals and tourists alike. It is known as one of the best brew pubs in British Columbia! You'll find an award-winning selection of handcrafted ales and lager on tap as well as some of the best food Squamish has to offer.

- 1:30 – 2:00pm Our final stop will be the Sea to Sky Gondola - You'll ride up to the vista point perched 2,900 feet (885 meters) above sea level. From this epic viewpoint, you'll have 360-degree views of Howe Sound in all its glory. We will be here for about 1 to 1 ½ hours.

We will board the bus around 3:30 – 3:45pm back to the hotel and should be back at the hotel around 4:30pm – 5:00pm
